



## Camp Scholarships 2026

### Parent/Student Information:

This year we have a variety of ways you can get involved and raise money for camp scholarships! We hope this allows your family the opportunity to send all of your eligible students to camp and raise as much funds as you may need, up to the total cost of your students' registration fees. The best part is that everyone can participate (mom, dad, grandparents, and students) in helping earn funds for your student!

### Fundraising Options:

**Soup & Chili Cookoff** - After church on **Sunday, Nov 9th** we'll have our annual Soup & Chili Cookoff. **Students & families may earn service hour scholarship money during clean up time as well as a 1 hr credit for entering a soup.** See Shay for details! This year's competition will include a "People's Choice" award. Therefore, invite your friends and family to join as everyone will have an opportunity to **vote with their money** for the soup or chili they find to be the best! Proceeds from this event will go into the camp fundraiser account to be distributed amongst campers. **Snack Shack** will also be open during Soup & Chili Sunday. All items \$1 or less (cash only).

**Cabin Fever Service Hours** – Connect with Pastor Sarah to schedule your service hours. Earn \$10 for each hour that you or your family works (\$10 per person, per hour)! Families who serve together, earn more together. Example tasks: decorating or set up/tear down for the event, helping at refreshments, hosting a game/activity station, etc. Times: **Sun, Jan 25, after church for chair/table moving, Wed, Jan 28, 7-8:30pm:** Glow Room set-up, **Fri, Jan 30 4-7:30pm:** Cotton candy prep, balloons/decor & station set up, Event Hours & clean up **Sat, Jan 31, 9:30 am-3pm.**

**Work Day - Fall & Spring work days - dates TBA.** Come prepared to help with indoor and outdoor projects. (No childcare provided, but some activities may be kid-work friendly). Earn \$10 for each hour that you or your family works (\$10 per person, per hour)!

**Silent Auction** - The online silent auction runs **March 6th-8th.** Proceeds from the auction will go into the camp fundraiser account to be distributed amongst campers. Would you be willing to donate a gift basket, gift card, lesson, product, or similar item to help our cause? All donation items for auction need to be received by Feb 25. **Students & families may earn service hour scholarship money to help organize auction items.
